

**"Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me."  
Psalms 51:10 KJV**

I strongly believe that God has His eyes on everyone's heart. Naturally our hearts beat to pump oxygenated blood throughout our veins to keep us alive but spiritually, our hearts are really the indicator of why we do what we do.

Medical doctors work on natural human hearts when they are not functioning right but it is only God who can help repair a spiritual heart functioning abnormally.

An abnormal heart to God is a heart carrying out actions with the wrong motives.



## THE SON

A wealthy man and his son loved to collect rare works of art. They had everything in their collection from Picasso to Raphael. They would often sit together and admire the great works of art.

When the Vietnam conflict broke out, the son went to war. He was very courageous and died in battle while rescuing another soldier. The father was notified and grieved deeply for his only son.

About a month later, there was a knock at his door. A young man stood at the door with a large package in his hands.
